10. Resourcing our ministry and mission a) Finance PW Finance Forum: PW has put together an appeal letter following the forum which. PW will circulate the draft of this letter. This includes asking for sponsorship for specific items.. ACW would ideally like a benefice wide approach. It was agreed to action the letter for Dedham now and draw in Ardleigh at a later date. 2019 Q4 provisional accounts – to be discussed at next meeting. iii. End of year accounts – to be finalised at next Finance Ctt meeting 4/2/20, then to be examined by Philip Strangward then to be formally approved at PCC meeting on 23rd March. b) Buildings **Quinquennial Works update** Gutter repairs: It had been agreed to spend up to £16,000, however the quote is coming in at between £16 to £18,000. PW is in contact with the architects. *Proposal to increase the* agreed spend up to £20,000 to repair the gutters, Proposed SW, seconded CF, all in favour. Toilets and Hospitality unit. PW updated the meeting with the progress. A faculty has been applied for and an unofficial response is that it has been agreed, PW is just awaiting the paperwork. Once the papers PW have been received public notice will be displayed for one month. PW to continue to chase up. Mr Gibbins the contractor has been appointed. Additional costs are likely as we will need to install a pumping station for the drains. Costs for both projects in region of iii. Organ working party update, The working party are meeting on 3rd February with ACW, PW, SW for an update. iv. Land Issue at Vicarage – no update to report. v. Repair to the wall between the churchyard and Vicarage PWgarden close to toilet block- A repair is needed, Peter Gibbin has given a quote. PW will email this to ACW. This work needs to be done, and will cost around £1000 for remedial repair. Proposed to spend £1000 on remedial repair, proposed VD, seconded CF, all in favour PWvi. Church Public Address System Upgrade proposal – A report has been supplied. Grants will be sought to pay for the works. It is expected to cost in the region of £3,000 to £4,000. Proposed to authorise the work to go ahead with a cost of £4,000 plus vat, proposed PW, seconded SW, all in favour. vii. **Lighting** – There is no emergency lighting in the church. This is a concern especially when outside organisations hire the building.
