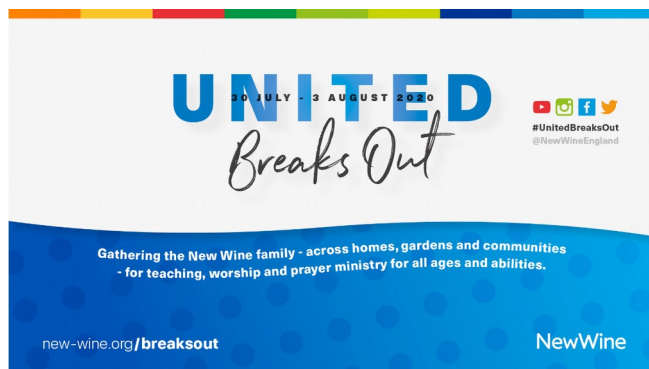
## ***A Hero of Intercession Count Zinzendorf: The noble Jesus freak***

Count Nikolaus Ludwig Zinzendorf was born in 1700 into an aristocratic Austro-German family. On leaving Halle Academy aged sixteen, Zinzendorf handed his professor a list of seven praying societies he'd established during his time at the school - quite the intercessor even as a teenager! At the age of twenty-two, when a ragtag band of refugees arrived on his estate at Berthelsdorf near Dresden, Zinzendorf permitted them to build a village on his land, which they called Herrnhut - 'The Lord's Watch'. On 13 August 1727, Zinzendorf gathered the Herrnhutters in the church at Berthelsdorf, and challenged them to apologise to one another for the quarrelling that had come to mark their fledgling community. As they did so, the Holy Spirit was poured out upon them in an overwhelming way. Two weeks later, twenty-four men and twenty-four women, inspired by Leviticus 6:13 - 'the scared fire was never permitted to go out on the altar' - covenanted together to pray continuously for one hour each through the day and night. And so began the prayer meeting that lasted non-stop night and day, for over a hundred years. Zinzendorf later recalled the transformation that took place as a result: 'The whole place represented truly a visible habitation of God among men.'

After five years of 24-7 prayer, Zinzendorf began sending out missionaries. Herrnhut would become the first and greatest missions base of the eighteenth century.

The life of Count Zinzendorf, 'the noble Jesus freak', boldly inspires us to a life of all-consuming love for Jesus and reminds us that the life of intercessory prayer not only changes us but truly changes the world. *I have one passion. It is he, only he. (Zinzendorf)*
