Organ Project at Dedham Church

The project to replace our pipe organ continues apace and with the organ loft empty, a structural engineer has assessed the current organ loft and concluded that no strengthening work is needed to take the weight of the new organ, which is very good news. In addition the fundraising target of £300,000, set by the PCC at the start of the project, has been reached and therefore this element of the overall project has been closed. Very grateful thanks indeed to everyone who has made a contribution. Finally, Nicholson's have started tuning our pipes in their workshop in Malvern which is the first real stage of bringing the Binns organ back to life. Photographs of this work are on display on a new board on the table by the pulpit.
